**DEFAULT JUDGMENT**

This matter came before this Court on April 4, 2008, on the Motion of Plaintiff, J&L Trailer Leasing, Inc., for a Default Judgment against Defendant, The Peaceful Center, Inc. After reviewing the record in this case, the Court finds that:

1. The Defendant leased trailers from the Plaintiff and has failed to pay the Plaintiff as required by the lease.
2. The Petition in this matter was filed on January 14, 2008 seeking recovery of the possession of the trailer.
3. An Affidavit from Plaintiff's counsel detailing the efforts undertaken to serve the Defendant was filed herein on February 28, 2008.
4. The Defendant has failed to answer, appear or otherwise plead in this matter within the 40 day period provided in Title 12 O.S. § 2004.C.3.
5. The Court conducted a judicial inquiry into the sufficiency of Plaintiff's search to determine the whereabouts of Defendant, and based on the evidence adduced the Court finds that Plaintiff has exercised due diligence and has conducted a meaningful search of all reasonably available sources at hand.

The Court approves the service given herein as meeting both statutory requirements and the minimum standards of state and federal due process.

**IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED, ADJUDGED, AND DECREED** that Plaintiff, J&L Trailer Leasing, Inc., is awarded a default judgment against the Defendant, The Peaceful Center, Inc., entitling the Plaintiff to possession of the following trailers which were listed in the Petition in this matter:


- a. Unit #148 Trailmobile, S/N #J94134
- b. Unit # 188 Fruehauf, S #150211
- c. Unit # 220-Strick, S #3119496

**IT IS FURTHER ORDERED** that the Court's Clerk of Oklahoma County shall issue a Writ of Assistance directing the Sheriff of Oklahoma County, Oklahoma to restore the Plaintiff to possession of the trailers described above.
